001 PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Belgiqa veneer panels create a seamless transition between wall and furniture. These MDF panels with a veneer finish are available in various selections and can be precisely cut to size. Perfectly matching Belgiqa parquet, veneer planks, and flexible veneer sheets, they ensure a harmonious and refined look in any interior.

001 GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Each Belgiqa veneer panel is built from two layers of real wood veneer with a sturdy 18 mm MDF core in between. Belgiqa panels can be used for both residential and commercial applications and are available in different wood types, gradings and colors.

Gradings Oak: Rift Mixmatch, Rift Crown Mixmatch, Natural Grade, ART Grade

Gradings Forgotten wood species: /

Dimensions: 3040 x 1220 x 19 mm

Thickness: MDF 18 mm, veneer 0,6 mm

Compositions: Top layer of real wood veneer stained and UV protected with color oil, applied sequentially by means of a rolling technique and intermediate curing; a core of MDF with a high density of 700 kg/m³ (±50 kg/m³) and a backing layer of veneer.

Bonding: The HPLT (High Pressure Low Temperature) press procedure used by Belgiqa guarantees the best quality for each panel. The process follows the DSI-method, ensuring complete saturation of the wood fibers and a significantly tight bond.

Applications: Belgiqa veneer panels are best suited for interior applications and easily fit into any commercial, retail, hospitality or residential project. Common applications include home or office cabinets, kitchen fronts, dressings, fixed furniture, reception desks, hotel closets, etc. Belgiqa veneer panels are suitable for horizontal use but are not recommended for horizontal use in kitchen, bathroom, or similarly humid areas.
