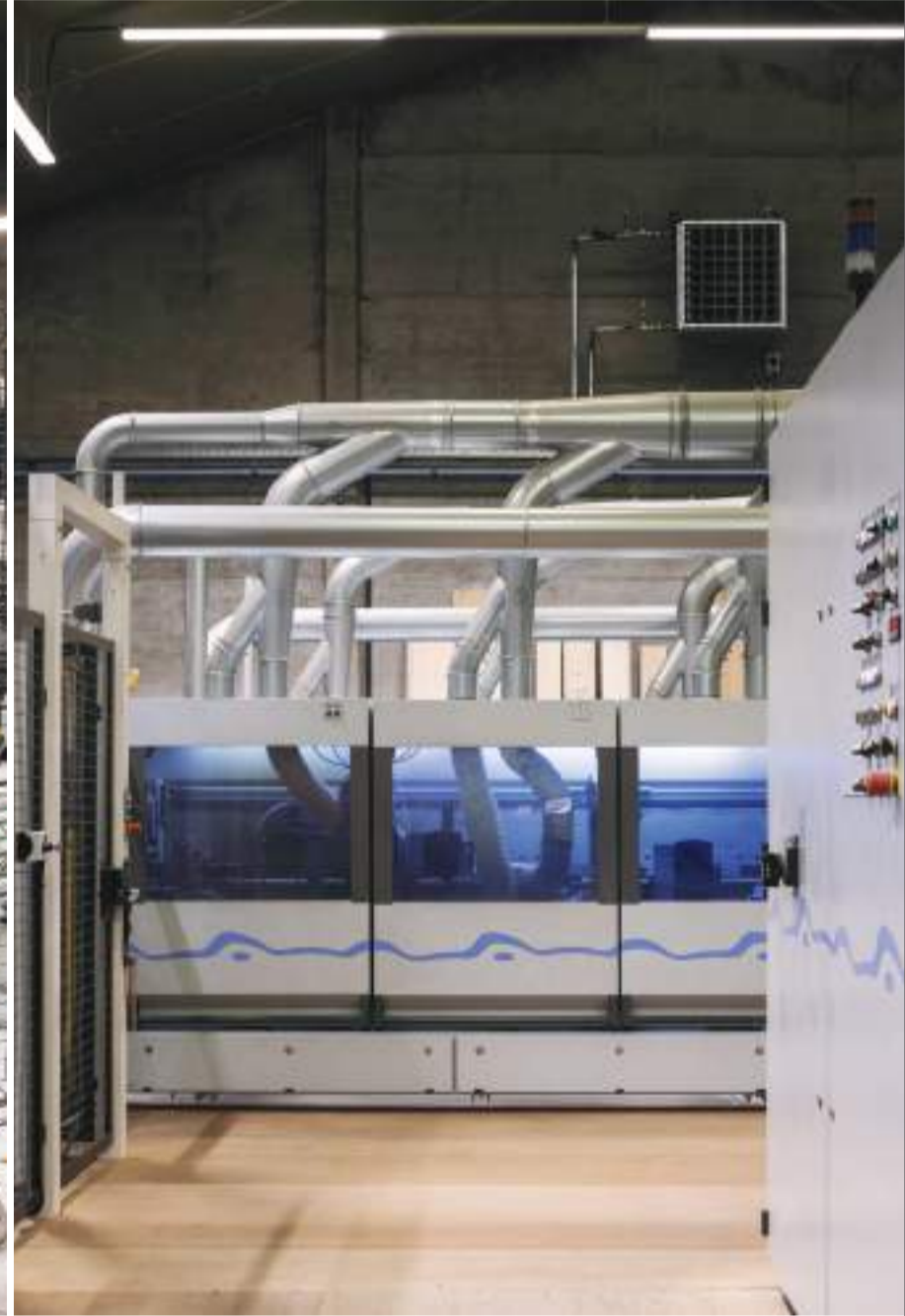

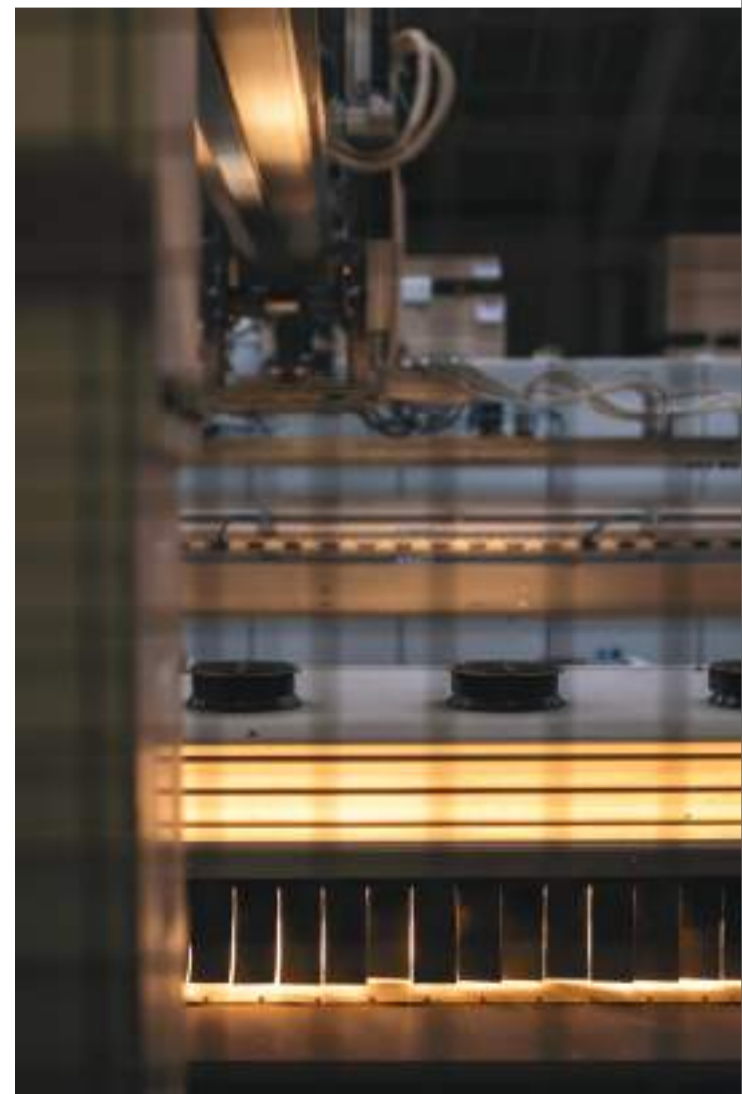

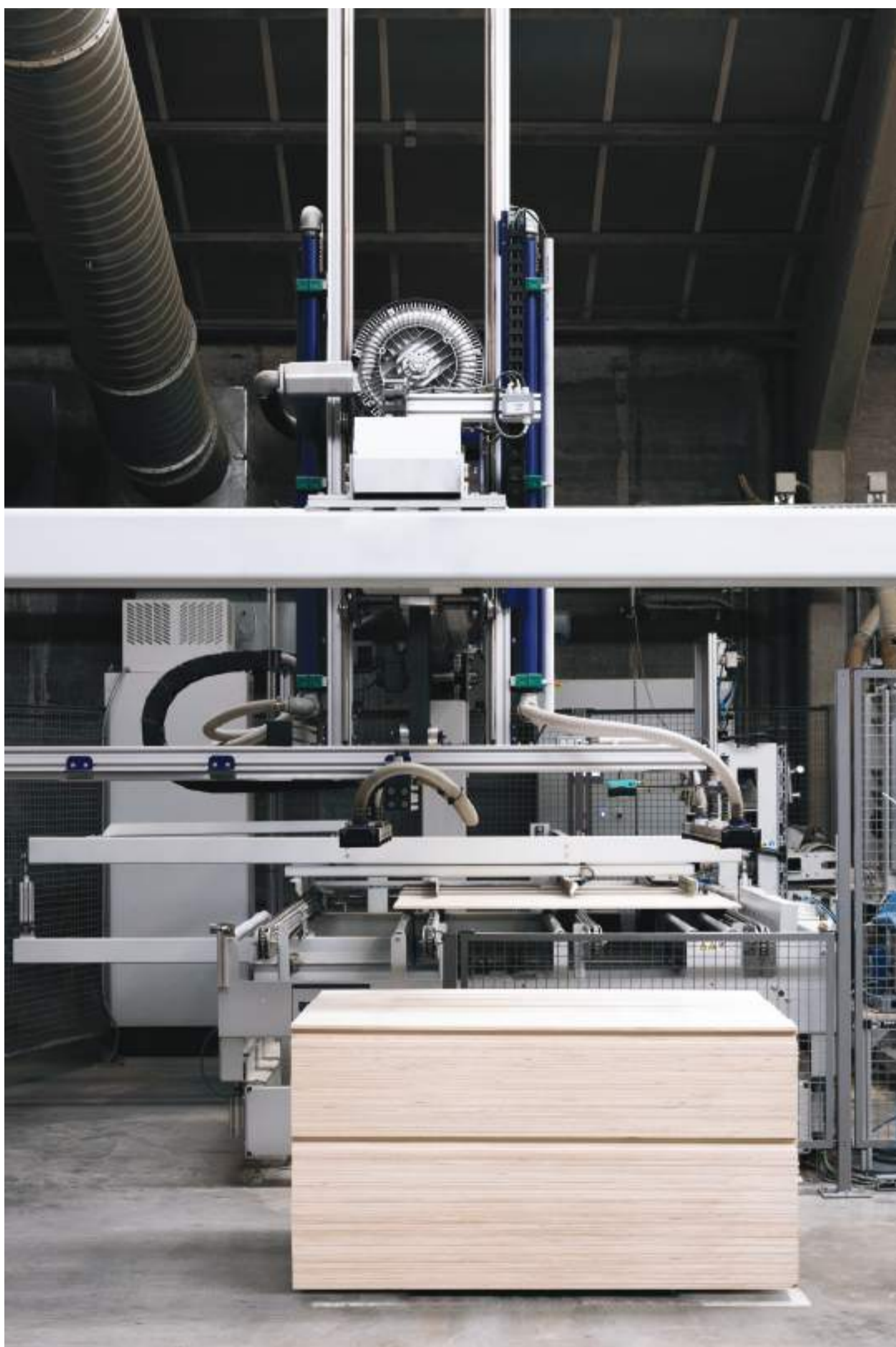


BELGIQA PRODUCTION

In 1920 Henri Vanlandschoot started off as a manufacturer of wood veneer for the high-end furniture industry. After a couple of successful years, the company decided to use its knowledge for the production of engineered wood flooring, resulting in perfectly pressed and profiled planks with an excellent fitting. With more than 100 years of experience, under the management of Henri's grandsons Kurt and Tom, Vanlandschoot has grown into one of the strongest players in its field. It became part of the joint venture Belgiqa a few years ago and now serves as our official production centre.

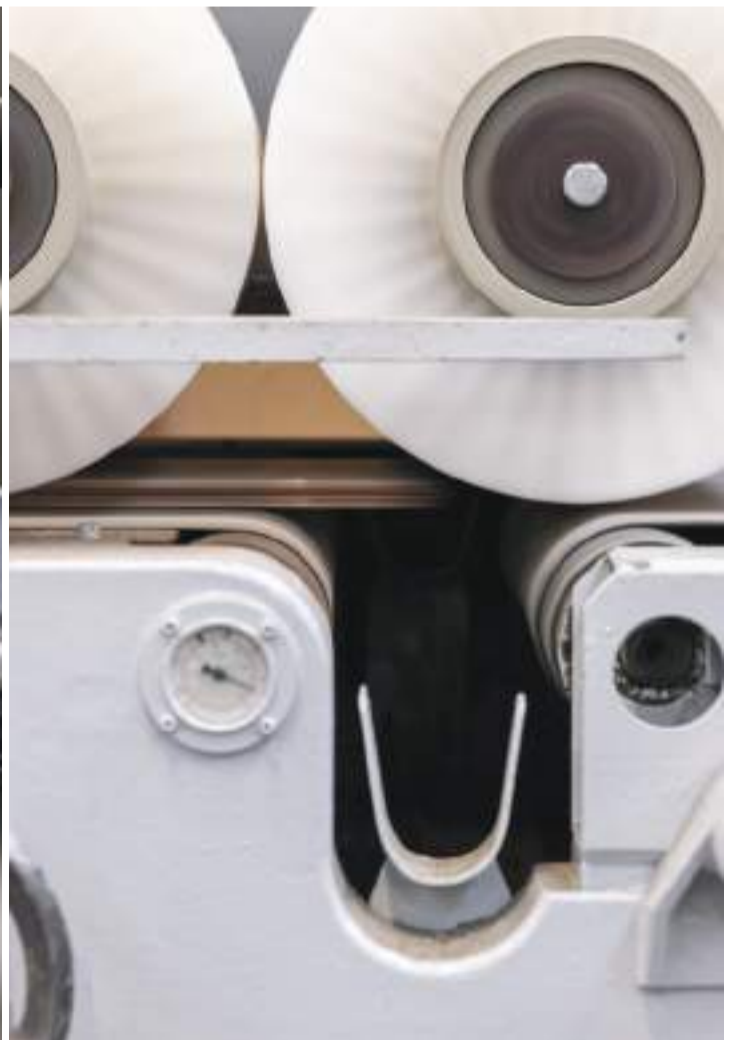




First, the sawn top layers are sorted by hand, after which they are glued to the plywood using a cold press technique. Belgîqa uses high-tech machines in the production process. This means we can guarantee a perfect fit. Afterwards, the boards are manually removed from the machines for an extra visual check.

THE FINISHING OF A BELGIQA BOARD

Ivan Soenens first started his car body shop in 1984, specialising in car painting and thus becoming an expert in matching colours, shades and textures. Much like Vanlandschoot, he later on decided to use this expertise for the finishing of wood flooring. The extreme precision that is needed for the painting of bodywork, is reflected in the high standards that Miva maintains for the colouring and finishing of Belgiqa's wood flooring.





In a nutshell, that's what Belgiqa does day in, day out. The possibilities for parquet finishing are endless. Depending on the customer's preferences, the planks may or may not be brushed, sanded, aged, or treated with a band saw. Subsequently, if desired, they are stained, oiled, or varnished. In certain collections, multiple stains are layered, tannins are added, or the planks are bleached, resulting in a more profound colouring.

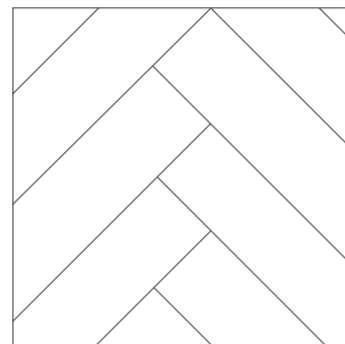
STRAIGHT FLOORBOARDS

The most common flooring pattern.



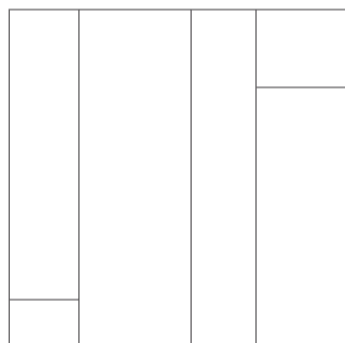
CHEVRON

The Chevron pattern consists of strips of the same width with the ends cut at an angle. The strips are laid in parallel to create chevrons.



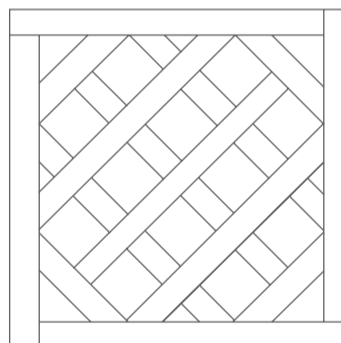
HERRINGBONE

Herringbone flooring is created by fitting together short planks at right angles in a staggered pattern.

Belgiqa's boards are available in a range of sizes. For a floor with more variation, it is also possible to alternate the use of several different widths.



VERSAILLES

Versailles is a flooring pattern consisting of pre-assembled square wooden panels, featuring a characteristic pattern of interlocking diagonals.

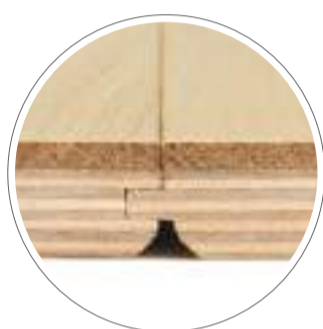

The boards are processed in a rotating drum filled with debris, creating visible scuff marks, scratches and dents. The resulting hardwood flooring is full of character and looks as if it's been in place for years.



03 BANDSAWN EFFECT

If you're looking for a more robust, hand-crafted look, a bandsaw effect might be just the thing for you. The bandsaw creates fine lines across the surface of the boards for a traditional appearance that recalls freshly sawn floorboards.



04 WOODSHIELD

If your goal is truly thorough protection, our Woodshield finish is what you need. This protective coating makes the boards water-resistant and provides optimal protection against stains. Woodshield makes your hardwood flooring exceptionally easy to maintain.

The boards are constructed using a multilayer core and are available in three gradings and a fixed range of widths and lengths. **Oak One** has a natural look and is a great basic choice. **Oak Four** in its turn is characterised by an authentic, weathered appearance and plywood core.

▶ **OAK RANGES: FIVE - SIX - SEVEN - EIGHT**

Oak Five – Oak Six – Oak Seven – Oak Eight include the same colours as well as more complex reactive colours and finishes. The planks are entirely customisable in terms of width, thickness and length. Even XXL planks are an option. **Oak Five** comes in four gradings, while **Oak Six**, **Oak Seven** and **Oak Eight** are available in six gradings.

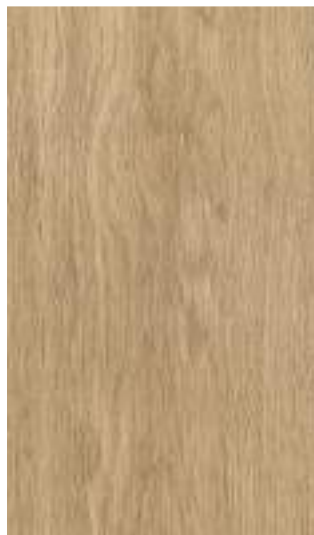

This collection differs from OAK TWO since the wood is treated with reactive stains and finished with pigmented oil. There are ten colours to choose from. OAK THREE is available in boards of 190 mm in width. The herringbone and chevron boards are also available in different dimensions. The collection comes in three gradings. Regular boards are finished with a micro-V bevel along the long edge and patterned floors have a micro-V bevel along all edges.

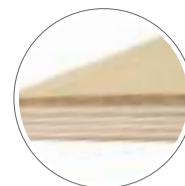

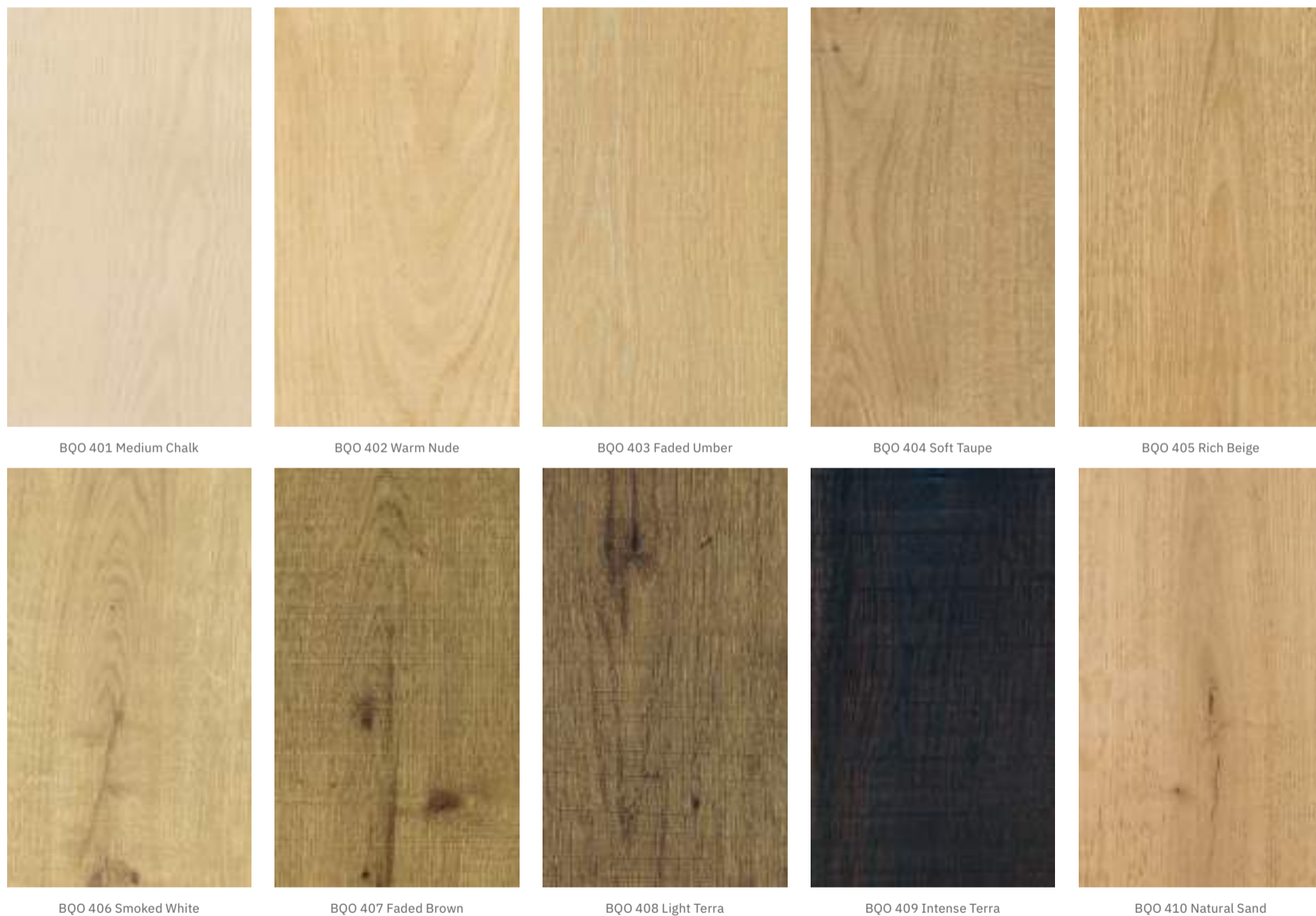


OAK FOUR

OAK FOUR consists of a plywood backing and a top layer in weathered oak. The boards have a very natural look because of the knots and marks left by the bandsaw. As with OAK THREE, the wood is treated with reactive stains and finished with pigmented oil. There are the same ten colours to choose from. OAK FOUR is also available in boards of 190 mm in width or in herringbones of 145 mm in width. Regular boards are finished with an aged bevel along the long edges and herringbone boards have an aged bevel along all edges.

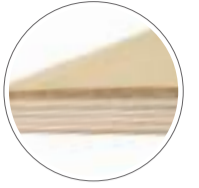

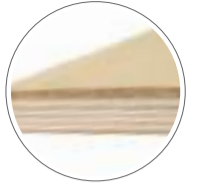

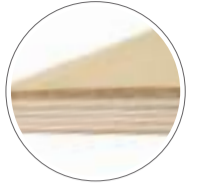

The combination of these reactive stains creates a depth of colour with a warm, natural appearance. The brushing ensures a refined look. There are twelve colours to choose from.
